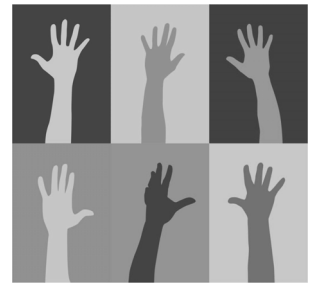


# **ARE YOU UP** **FOR A NEW** **CHALLENGE?**

## ***Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Committee***

### **Some aims of the EDI Committee include:**

- ⇒ Promoting and encouraging the inclusion of girls and adults from all walks of life into IGG.
- ⇒ Raising awareness of all IGG members to the difficulties and challenges faced by the target groups - people with disabilities, people with behavioural problems, people from low socio-economic backgrounds, people from all Faiths, members from the Traveller Community, people from minority ethnic groups.
- ⇒ Training IGG Leaders to meet these challenges and work with members from the target groups.
- ⇒ Training women from within the target groups to become IGG Leaders.

### **We are also looking to fill the following three positions on the EDI Committee:**

#### **Chairman**

The Chairman should have some experience in the areas mentioned above and be confident to lead her committee to fulfil its aims.

EDI meetings will take place 4-5 times per year. The Chairman will be a member of the National Programme and Training Committee (NPT) and is expected to attend NPT meetings (approximately 5 per year).

#### **Faith Advisor**

She will need to be familiar with the Spiritual aspects of the IGG programmes. The responsibility of the Faith Advisor will be to monitor, promote and develop the ***Spiritual element*** within IGG and its programmes.

#### **Development Education Representative**

She will need to be familiar with the Development Education aspects of the IGG programmes. The responsibility of the Development Education representative will be to monitor, promote and develop the ***Development Education element*** within IGG and its programmes, for instance the *Development Education Resource Pack*.
