It is important that Leaders and Commissioners portray a good public image, give a good example to the girls and are proud of their uniform.

Leaders' and Commissioners' Uniform

- The Leaders' and Commissioners' inner and outer uniform tops should be worn with navy trousers or a navy skirt.
- Leaders and Commissioners may wear plain blue jeans or navy tracksuit bottoms to Unit meetings and non-public events, but not for formal occasions.
- For formal occasions (e.g. St. Patrick's Day parades, IGG trainings and conferences) Leaders and Commissioners should wear inner/outer uniform tops with navy trousers or a navy skirt.
- Shoes should be navy, brown or black. Runners may be worn with trousers. Tights should be unpatterned natural, navy or barely black.
- Jewellery should not be excessive.

- Leaders and Commissioners may wear a purple neckerchief with a black woggle or the silk fuchsia scarf with the silver scarf ring.
- The President's woggle (for 10years service) may be worn on the neckerchief or fuchsia scarf.
- The Promise badge must be worn by all enrolled Leaders and Commissioners. They may choose whether they wear the old trefoil with which they were enrolled or the new Promise badge. However, they may not wear both of them at the same time.
- The new Leaders' Promise badge has a purple celtic knot and the new Commissioners' Promise badge has a silver celtic knot.
- The badge tab should be worn on the right side of the inner/outer top, in line with the logo.
- Pin badges only may be worn on the official badge tab (but not button badges). See list below.
- A maximum of four of the following badges only may be worn on the badge tab:

Trefoil/Promise badge, Warrant Pin, World badge, CIGA pin, Service Badge, Trainer Bar, Camp/Holiday Qualification.

If preferred the Trefoil/Promise badge may be worn on the neckerchief/scarf.
- Commissioners should wear their name/title badge above the official badge tab.

Unit Helpers

- Unit Helpers do not wear uniform, but may wear an orange neckerchief.
